1. Menu Bar


At the bottom of the screen, you will find the menu bar



You can easily switch between the different menu options by clicking on the icons


2. Portfolio

Here you can monitor and set up your personal watchlists







Here you can search the markets for specific CFDs











In the portfolio section you can monitor your open positions and orders. Select









2. Adding Take profit & Stop loss

To add a stop loss or profit taker to an existing position, click on the position, toggle the option and set the price. You will see the updated position. If you wish to cancel or modify these orders, simply click on the position and repeat the process again.





To blend in the chart, click on the chart symbol







3. Closing a trade

To close a trade, click on the position and select **Close Trade**. The order ticket will open, verify the information and click **Close Position**.

There too, you can blend in the chart









4. Closing all positions

To close all positions at once, click on the dashed line symbol at the top right of your screen, and select Close All Positions. You will be asked for confirmation, click on Close All to proceed. You can do the same for all orders, if you're in the order section of the portfolio page. In that case, click on Cancel All Orders

You can also switch between **Simple** and **Netted** View for your positions and orders.







1. Watchlists


On this page you will find your watchlists. You can edit the default watchlist or create your own.


You can do this by accessing the watchlist settings at the top right of your screen:




Click on **Create a new** watchlist and name it.


Please keep in mind that creating many watchlists containing many instruments can have a negative impact on your app's speed.

You can also add CFDs to your watchlist by clicking on the star symbol








2. Managing watchlists

Manage watchlists in the settings.








3. Quick trading

Enabling quick trading will allow you to place trades without needing to confirm your action.



Tip: You can open a trade by swiping left (buy) or right (sell) on the contract. This will also allow you to mark the contract as a favourite, acces a chart and further information on the market.




1 Overview


On this page you can browse all CFD markets. You can also search for specific contracts.




3. Charting - simple chart

Under **Overview** on the contract page, you will find the default chart.




5. General chart settings

Change your preferences here

Selects the time frame. This can be done directly in the chart as well

Choose between bid, mid and ask price for the chart



Choose between 11 types of charts

Choose whether you want sub-positions to be showed separately or as a single netted position (using average price)

TRADING -




1. Market Order

Click on buy or sell in a chart or a watchlist, this will open the order ticket. For a market order, select **Trade**, enter the **Amount** and then click on **Place Buy Trade**. The app will send out a market order which will be executed at the best price available.

If you wish to add a Take profit (TP), a Stop loss (SL) or create a hedged position, toggle the corresponding options. For the TP and SL, enter the desired price.


The required funds needed to open the position will be displayed at the bottom of the screen.



2. Adding contingent orders to an existing position

If you wish to add, remove or

modify your TP & SL, go to your portfolio, and click on the position. This will open the **Trade information** where you can edit your contingent orders. To close the position, click **Close Trade**.




3. Limit/Stop Orders

If you wish to open a position using a limit or a stop order, after clicking on buy or sell, select **Order** in the order ticket. Enter the price, the amount and click on Place Buy Order.




As with market orders, you can add contingent orders, or open a hedge trade. You can choose between a

Good until Cancelled or Good until Time



If you select Good until Time, enter the date and time until which you want the order to be active below.



4. Closing a position

If you wish to close a position, click on your position and then on Close Trade
